This trial school will consist of lectures, demonstrations, and labs, where attendees will get firsthand experience participating in trial procedure based on the facts of an actual child sexual abuse case. This course requires the active participation of attendees, including case materials to read prior to arrival at the trial school, as well as preparing for labs on the attendee's own time the evenings of the trial school.

Registration is limited to 60 attendees. Once you are accepted to the course, there will be a <u>non-refundable</u> registration fee of \$50 per attendee. The entire cost of this training is \$405 per person, but Children's Justice Act Task Force has generously provided 60 scholarships in the amount of \$355, leaving the total cost for the trial school at \$50 per attendee.
